SUBJECT: JUNE STATUS REPORT FOR NAPA RIVER FISH MONITORING

Dear Mike:

The following Napa Monthly Status Report summarizes the work conducted in June 2003 for the USACE by the Stillwater Sciences Team. An invoice for the level of task completion through June 2003 is being sent under separate cover.

Task 1201 - Database

Data for June sampling will be available on the website following QA/QC.

Task 1203 - Internet Site

The internet site has been established, and access granted to the public. A variety of data queries are available on the web site.

Task 1306 – Status report for June 2003

This June 2003 status report is included on the June 2003 invoice.

Task 1406 – Field sampling for June 2003

Field sampling in June occurred on 7 and 8 June 2003. Methods consisted of fyke netting, beach seining, otter trawling, and purse seining.

The beach seine effectively fished at Site 1A-4 (north and south end of the SWOA) and 1A-3 (marsh plain terrace), during the high and flooding tide. At Site 1A-4, the beach seine collected carp, inland silverside, shimofuri goby, yellowfin goby, and staghorn sculpin. At Site 1A-3, the beach seine collected inland silverside, shimofuri goby, striped bass, threespine stickleback, tule perch, Sacramento sucker, staghorn sculpin, yellowfin goby, starry flounder, and Sacramento splittail.

The otter trawl fished at SWOA Slough Site 1A-2 and open water river Sites 1A-1, 2-1, and 1B-1. The otter trawl collected striped bass, carp, shimofuri goby, yellowfin goby, Sacramento splittail, starry flounder, and staghorn sculpin.

Fyke nets fished at Sites 1A-6, 1A-7, and 1A-10, and captured shimofuri goby, inland silverside, striped bass, yellowfin goby, and staghorn sculpin.

The purse seine was fished at Site 3-1 and captured no fish.

Field data sheets are attached to this report.

Task 1506 – Data Analysis for June 2003

Data collected during the June field trip is being Q/C'ed and entered into the database.

Upcoming Activities

Field activities for the next month will occur on 7 and 8 July 2003. This will be the last field sampling for 2003 unless additional funding is obtained.
