SUBJECT: JUNE STATUS REPORT FOR NAPA RIVER FISH MONITORING

Dear Mike:

The following Napa Monthly Status Report summarizes the work conducted in June 2004 for the USACE by the Stillwater Sciences Team. An invoice for the level of task completion through June 2004 is being sent under separate cover.

Task 1201 - Database

Data for May and June sampling will be available on the website following QA/QC.

Task 1203 - Internet Site

The internet site has been established, and access granted to the public. A variety of data queries are available on the web site.

Task 1306 – Status report for June 2004

This June 2004 status report is included on the June 2004 invoice.

Task 1406 – Field sampling for June 2004

Field sampling in June occurred on 15 and 16 June 2004. Methods consisted of fyke netting, beach seining, otter trawling, and purse seining.

The beach seine was effectively fished at Sites 1A-4 (north and south end of the SWOA), 1A-3 (marsh plain terrace), 1B-2 (marsh plain terrace), and 2-2 (marsh plain terrace) during the flooding tide. Carp, inland silverside, rainwater killifish, shimofuri goby, striped bass, threadfin shad, yellowfin goby, staghorn sculpin, Sacramento splittail, Sacramento sucker, starry flounder, largemouth bass, threespine stickleback and tule perch were captured at the beach seine sites.

The otter trawl was fished at SWOA Slough Site 1A-2 and open water river Sites 1A-1, 2-1, and 1B-1. The otter trawl collected American shad, carp, inland silverside, shimofuri goby, striped bass, and Sacramento splittail.

Fyke nets were fished at Sites 1A-6, 1A-7, and 1A-10 and captured inland silverside, shimofuri goby, yellowfin goby, and Sacramento splittail.

The purse seine was fished at Site 3-1 and captured American shad and inland silversides.

Field data sheets for June are attached to this status report.

Task 1504 – Data Analysis for early April 2004

Data collected during the early April field trip was Q/C'ed and entered into the database.

Task 1514 – Data Analysis for late April 2004

Data collected during the late April field trip was Q/C'ed and entered into the database.

Task 1515 – Data Analysis for May 2004

Task 1506 – Data Analysis for June 2004

Data collected during the June field trip is being Q/C'ed and entered into the database.
